General information: Citizen panel “*Paleo experts*”

1. The Citizen panel “Paleo experts” is an additional research unit formed by interested citizens who are an active part of the research project “Neanderthals and us”.
2. The project/ research language in the meetings, lectures and discussions will be English. However, individual questions and comments can be translated from German to English, English to German, as well as from Dutch to English, English to Dutch.
3. Abstracts of the lectures are available in advance in English, Dutch and German.
4. The members of the Citizen panel meet at six planned community meetings for an active exchange with researchers, who talk about their own research approaches in lectures, followed by discussion rounds or Q&A sessions with the panel members.
5. The workshops have a duration of 2-3 hours.
6. The travel costs for participation in the community meeting will be covered by the project upon submission of invoices. However, a maximum reimbursement of 25€ per community meeting applies.
7. The Neanderthal Museum Mettmann organizes and coordinates the Community Meeting, as well as the cultural and community actions addressed as Benefit. Participation in the Citizen panel is voluntary and interest based and is not monetarily rewarded!
8. The members of the Citizen panel receive a certificate of honor at the end of the project.

Purpose of data processing and legal basis:

Data processing by the Neanderthal Museum Foundation is essentially based on the relevant legal provisions, as well as the data protection provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act of North Rhine-Westphalia. In addition, processing may be based on the disclosure of data by the data subject on the basis of consent or voluntary indication.

Recipients and categories of recipients of the data:

In principle, personal data may only be processed and passed on for the purpose for which it was originally collected.

In our company, the data collected is therefore only passed on to the persons responsible for sending the newsletter. In this case, the data is transferred to a third party, i.e. to the data processor rapid mail GmbH, with the help of which we can ensure the smooth dispatch of the newsletter. Of course, there is a contractual arrangement within the framework of order processing.

Duration of storage:

The Neanderthal Museum Foundation is entitled and obliged to process and store personal data within the framework of the legitimate fulfilment of its tasks. This data is stored for as long as it is required for the fulfilment of the task.

The duration of the storage of personal data is measured according to the relevant statutory retention periods of all currently valid legal provisions in conjunction with the European Data Protection Regulation and all other data protection provisions. You may unsubscribe from the newsletter at any time. In this case, your data will be deleted from our system with immediate effect.

Rights of data subjects:

Data subjects have the following rights under the EU General Data Protection Regulation if the legal and personal requirements are met:

- Right of access to personal data processed
According to Art. 15 DS-GVO, data subjects have the right to obtain information from the controller about the data stored by the controller.
- Right to rectification of inaccurate data
If the data subject discovers that the data stored about him or her is incorrect, he or she has a right to have the data corrected in accordance with Art. 16.
- Right to erasure or restriction of data processing
According to Art. 17 and 18, data subjects have the right to have the stored data deleted, provided that retention periods do not prevent this.
- Right to object to data processing due to special circumstances
Under the conditions of Art. 21, data subjects have the possibility to object to data processing in certain cases for the future or to have it restricted.

- Right to revoke consent given

Data subjects have the right to revoke given consent for the future.
